Surf Soccer Club is very pleased to announce it's new Surf College Program. The program is designed to educate Surf families about the college recruitment process and provide opportunities to see various levels of college play, meet with college recruiters and coaches, participate in college tours, and attend informal question and answer and/or training sessions with select college coaches.

The College Program will be directed by Tony Bruce, who has extensive knowledge and experience with the recruitment process. Tony will be making grade specific presentation to high school aged Surf players and their families beginning in the end of September. Presentation will educate players about the college recruitment process and facilitate player self-assessment as to where they are in big picture of college recruiting. Other aspects of the College Program will include meetings with individual college coaches and opportunities for players to train with various college coaches playing in the San Diego area. Tony will be attending college games with Surf players and will be arranging question and answer and training sessions with college coaches in conjunction with some of these games.
